- successful graduates earn a Master of Science in Engineering from Ecole Supérieure d'Agricultures Angers Loire (ESA)
- work for a minimum of two and a half years for the sponsoring company in Spain after the program in France.

Successful completion of the program earns an entry-level management position in the sponsoring company's industrial site in Spain after the end of the program.

## Requirements:

Candidates must have:

- A completed Bsc or Msc in one of the following domains Food Sciences,
  Agronomy, Food production, Microbiology
- a strong motivation for a career in the dairy industry
- A **certified B2 level in English** (equivalent of 700 points in TOEIC)
- A good level of French at least A2 if you are coming after June 2022
- A desire to learn new cultures and a new language (French)
- A real capacity to overcome challenges and to develop new competencies
- An experience abroad would be appreciated

You must be <u>under 28 on September 1st 2023</u> to apply (French labor law contract)

The selection process is in two steps. ESA will examine your application and will contact you for a first interview in English by one of their team. If ESA decides you are a solid candidate, we will pass your file on to the company.

ESA will then arrange final interviews with the local team and candidates. The company makes the final choice. The program begins in early June 2023 for those who need additional French lessons (already an A2 level) and August 2023 for French speakers (B2 level).
